1. What do you like best about parades? What do you like least?
2. If you had a year's wages to spend on friends, how would you choose to spend it?
3. How do you think our local television newscast would have covered and described Jesus' triumphant entrance?
4. What had happened to swell the crowd?
5. What experiences did Jesus have that stand in contrast to the enthusiasm being expressed by the people here as they welcomed Jesus to Jerusalem?
6. What do you think the crowd's hopes and dreams were, as they welcomed Jesus?
7. Why did Jesus choose to ride into town on the lowly donkey? (Zec. 9: 9)
8. What do you think the crowds, the disciples, and the Jewish leaders were feeling on that first Palm Sunday?
9. What convinced you that Jesus is your personal King?
10. What's the best thing you've experienced about the type of King Jesus is?
11. How does our worship compare to the kind of welcome we would like Jesus to experience as we gather each week?
